AWARD APPLICATION FOR THE NORTH CENTRAL ZONE

One of the objectives of the Retired Educators of New York (RENY) is to work toward the advancement of education in the state and country. In an attempt to help meet that objective, RENY has developed a \$2,000.00 grant award to assist full time educators with an innovative program or project. This grant will be issued in June, 2026.

To be eligible for this award an educator must be a full-time teacher/administrator in a public school system within the areas covered by the North Central Zone of RENY (Jefferson and Lewis Counties).

The application will be for the entire \$2,000.00. It may be used for a variety of purposes such as a program to enhance student improvement, behavior, or self-esteem.

The applicant must provide a description of any program or project and demonstrate why the grant is needed.

The winner of the award will be determined by a team of judges and award applications must be returned by **May 15, 2026.**

The winner of the award will be notified by the end of May for the presentation at our annual June luncheon.

5. How will the project/program contribute to student academic growth and/or enrichment?
6. Give a reasonably detailed account of how the grant money will be spent.
